As you read, identify the two types of conflict: **internal conflict** and **external conflict**. External conflicts are problems experienced by the main character (protagonist) that are created by outside characters or forces - often times, the antagonist. The different types of external conflicts are categorized as: *Man vs. Man, Man vs. Nature, Man vs. Society, Man vs. Technology*, and *Man vs. Fate*.

Internal conflicts are problems felt within the character – often times the protagonist. These conflicts are emotions and feelings that the protagonist experiences during the story. Internal conflict is categorized as: *Man vs. Self*.

Identify Internal and External Conflicts

External Conflicts: Describe the conflict, which character is experiencing it, and write what type of conflict it is: *Man vs. Man*, etc.

Internal Conflicts: Describe the conflict, who is experiencing it, and what caused the feeling or emotion
